Education and Experience

Ke Zang studied Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (AOM) at Liaoning University of Traditional Chinese Medicine in Shenyang, Liaoning, China from September 1987 to July 1992. This five-year program consisted of 9,600 hours of education including 2,880 hours of clinical practice. After graduation, he earned his Bachelor's Degree in Medicine and worked as a medical doctor specializing in Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine in the Department of Rehabilitation at Liaoning Friendship Hospital in Shenyang, Liaoning, China until August 2001 when he came to the U.S. for further education.

Ke Zang enrolled in the chiropractic program at New York Chiropractic College (NYCC) in August 2002. While studying chiropractic medicine, he became a professor and taught AOM at Finger Lakes School of AOM at NYCC from 2003 to 2007. He also treated patients as a licensed acupuncturist in the professional clinic at NYCC during that time. He was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture in November 2006 and Oriental Medicine and Chinese Herbology in November 2007 by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM). This included earning a certification in Clean Needle Technique. Ke Zang also taught AOM at AOMA Graduate School of Integrative Medicine at Austin, TX from 2007 to 2008. In 2008, he began an integrated private practice of AOM and treated patients in Kirkland, WA until moving to Denver, CO in 2016.

Ke Zang's training in AOM includes acupuncture and adjunctive therapies such as herbal medicine, moxibustion, Tui Na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, and dietary and lifestyle recommendations. He is a licensed acupuncturist in Colorado, New York, Texas and Washington. None of these licenses have ever been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are used.
